Dear Parent/ Carer,

A number of families have been contacting us about the criteria for a child to come into the Academy to work if their parent(s) are key workers.

We need to keep our school communities safe. Wherever possible, children should stay at home. In our communities, it is imperative that we keep transmission rates low and to do this, numbers of staff and children in schools need to be kept a minimum. Places for children of critical workers should only be taken up if absolutely necessary. Places will be prioritised for vulnerable children, who are expected to attend school full time.

Critical workers are defined as those working in:

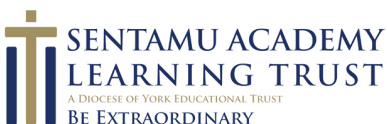
- Health and social care
- Education and childcare
- Local and national government
- Food and other necessary goods
- Public safety and national security
- Transport and border
- Utilities, communication and financial services

Critical workers must book their place by Friday 8th January using the info@sentamuacademy.org email address or call the Academy on 781912 in order to secure places for the lockdown period. Should circumstances change for parents with regards critical worker status, evidence must be provided to demonstrate this.

If pupils are eligible for free school meals but are not attending school, parents/carers must contact the school regarding collection please use the wellbeing@sentamuacademy.org email address or, again call the Academy on 781912
