Many of you will have heard what the Prime Minister said last night in his address to the nation.

We are immediately switching to remote learning for all students in year 7-13.

Our remote learning package is a mixture of Google Meet (live lessons) and Google Classroom (online work set for students to complete in their own time). Years 11 and 13 must complete all their work because we do not know yet what process will be in place to replace external examinations.

For students to be able to access the Google Meet live lessons they will need to have returned the remote learning permission form. These were distributed in November. Children of key workers or vulnerable children can still attend the Academy. We will arrange suitable work and a laptop to use.
