

Dear Parent / Carer

You will have seen details in the news this week about the next steps in getting back to normal.

This has been a very challenging year for students and their families and we will be writing to you shortly with details about the end of term and the start of the new Academy Year in September.

In this letter I want to tell you about our Covid safety procedures in the **last week of term**.

As an Academy we are continuing to keep students in bubbles for the last week and we will continue to ask students to wear masks in the Academy. I would ask you to continue to use the lateral flow testing kits provided and to share with us any positive results. Due to the rising rate of Covid in Hull we have been asked as an Academy to continue to track and trace in the last week and identify close contacts for self-isolation.

These measures are being kept in place to keep everyone as safe as possible as we approach the summer break and also they reflect the fact that cases are rising nationally and in our local area.

Provided national guidance remains the same, you will be pleased to know that school will return to a normal non-Covid style operation in September; no bubbles, no masks. We will confirm this nearer the time as the national picture can change for us all at any point.
